Scholarship Awards

1. Chicago Regional Chapter - Carl Samans Excellence Award (\$1500 – up to two awards)

The Carl Samans Award is a memorial award in honor of Dr. Carl Samans. Among his many accomplishments, Dr. Samans was a member of ASM for 47 years, past president and trustee of ASM International, Assistant Director of Research for American Oil (Amoco) and served on the faculty of Lehigh University, Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute and Penn State University. The purpose of this award is to recognize and encourage outstanding graduate and undergraduate students to continue their pursuit of a career in materials science and metallurgical engineering. The award is for \$1500.00 and goes directly to the student.

2. Chicago Regional Chapter Undergraduate Scholarship (\$1000 – up to three awards)

The Chicago Regional Chapter Award recognizes and encourages undergraduate students to pursue careers in the materials science and metallurgical engineering. The award money goes directly to the student.

3. Chicago Regional Chapter Graduate Scholarship (\$1000 – up to three awards)

The Chicago Regional Chapter Award recognizes and encourages graduate students to pursue careers in the materials science and metallurgical engineering. The award money goes directly to the student.

Eligibility Requirements

All graduate/undergraduate students beyond Freshman year majoring, or considering study of Material Science & Engineering, Physics, Computer Science or Mechanical Engineering (concentration in the material applications only) at any of the Chicago regional institutions, including the Illinois Institute of Technology, Northwestern University, Northern Illinois University (Naperville) and University of Illinois at Chicago are eligible.

- Personal projects & Campus activities
- Faculty or supervisor recommendation letter
- Essay (max. 500 words) for Award to which you are applying
